The Purpose of the Code:

The Purpose of the Calgary Rams code of conduct is to ensure that all members, parents and volunteers involved with the club understand the expectations of participating in our club in all environments to maintain a fun, safe, inclusive and respectful environment for all to enjoy.

Code of Conduct:

Calgary Rams Rugby Club members have responsibilities on and off the pitch. Members will:

- Consistently demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship, leadership, inclusiveness and ethical behavior:
- Compete and participate in a spirit of fair play, honesty and respect for the opponent, the officials and all supporters;
- Compete and participate within the laws of the game and/or any rules specific to a particular competition/tournament;
- At all times show and uphold respect for all players, coaches, officials, team managers and supporters
- Refrain from any behavior that may constitute any sort of harassment/unwanted interaction with others:
- Refrain from the abuse of power or authority (whether formally or informally given)
- Respect the property of others and do not willfully cause damage or harm;
- In the case of individuals who meet the legal age of consumption (Alcohol and Cannabis), take reasonable steps to manage the responsible and safe consumption of said product at all rugby related events;

Breaches and Complaints

- 1. Any complaints, concerning a violation or breach of this Code of Conduct by a member shall be communicated to one of the members of the current executive. Complaints shall be reviewed and dealt with by the current executive.
- 2. If any member of the Calgary Rams Rugby club fails to comply with this Code of Conduct, on or off the field of play, the member may be subject to disciplinary action which may include reprimand, suspension or expulsion from the Calgary Rams Rugby Club.
